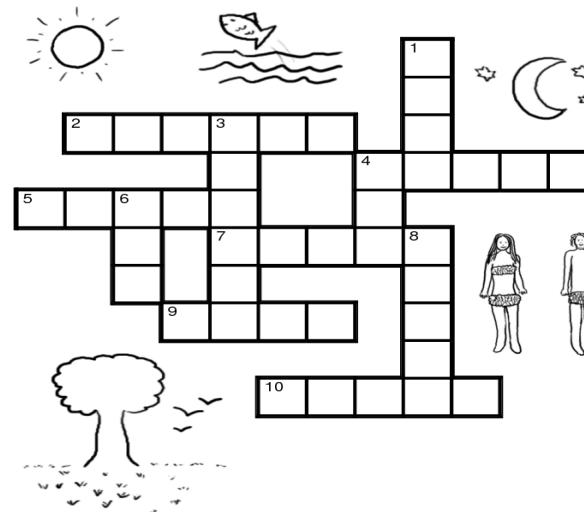
Day for Life
